Character Creation Worksheet

Helps kids design unique fantasy figures.

How to Use:

Print one copy per child. Ask kids to draw, name, and write a short backstory for their character.

Tips:

Use before costume dress-up to inspire identity and storytelling.

Superhero Mask Templates

Printable masks to customize hero identities.

How to Use:

Print and cut out masks on cardstock. Use crayons, markers, or stickers to decorate.

Tips:

Attach string or elastic band for wearable masks. Ideal for Superhero Academy.

Potion Recipe Cards

Fun potion experiments for magical learning.

How to Use:

Print on cardstock or laminate. Use with safe kitchen materials (baking soda, food dye, etc.).

Tips:

Assign story names or magic effects to each potion for creative role-play.

Time Traveler Timeline

Interactive journey through different historical eras.

How to Use:

Print and cut the timeline into segments. Let kids pin events onto a wall or board in order.

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Tips:

Include QR codes or facts behind each era for deeper learning.

Puppet Theater Script Pack

Simple play scripts for performance activities.

How to Use:

Print and distribute short plays. Kids can act with puppets or dress-up costumes.

Tips:

Ideal for shy performers-encourages speaking through characters.
