
Forest & Ocean-Inspired Sailboat Craft

Sail Template (Cut and Use)

Use this triangular guide to trace and cut your sails from burlap or scrap fabric.



Build Checklist

- 3 branches for boat base (similar size)
- 1 straight stick for mast
- Burlap or scrap cloth cut into triangle sails
- Twine, jute, or string
- Glue (hot glue or craft glue)
- Scissors
- Optional: buttons, felt, pine sprigs, wooden discs

Before Building:

- What materials are you using?
- What do you want your sailboat to look like?
- What will your boat be called?

After Building:

- Did the structure hold together well?
- How did you attach the sails?
- What was your favorite part?
- If you built it again, what would you change?

Write a short story about where your boat sails and what it discovers.
